# **Update on Aquatic Herbicide Permits Issued for Phragmites Control**

Please submit permit applications as early as possible submissions in September or October may not be reviewed and processed in time for treatments to occur



# Why a Permit is Needed

## **Legislative Requirements**

- Ontario *Pesticide Act* and Regulation 63/09 requires a permit for an aquatic extermination if an exemption does not apply
- There is no cost associated with the application and issuance of a permit



#### **Environmental Protection**

- Prevents arbitrary use
- Limits treatment areas
- Permits control of invasive species
- Reduces environmental impacts
- Ensures proper public notification of treatments





# Pesticide Licence Requirements

- Aquatic Vegetation Licence
- Authority to use registered aquatic herbicides for a water extermination
- Training for the exterminator on the safe legal use of aquatic herbicides
- Certification administered by Ontario Pesticide Training and Certification
- Self study course followed by written test
- 75% required to pass
- Successful candidates receive a certificate and then apply for a licence
- If running a pest control business, an operator licence is also required
- Requesting proof that the individual has the appropriate exterminator licence and an operator licence can be helpful to ensure the contractor is properly trained
   and insured.







# **Exemptions From Pesticide Licences and Permits**

#### Licence exemptions apply if:

 The person who performs the extermination is the owner/occupier of the premises or full-time employee of the owner/occupier and the extermination is conducted completely within the property boundaries. Reg 63/09 S 83(1)(2)

#### Permit exemptions apply if:

- The application is in a drainage ditch\*;
   and
- The exterminator uses a Class B, C or D where the label permits the use; and
- The pesticide is used to control plants that float on or emerge from the surface of the water; and
- There is no moving water at the time of the extermination





# Permit Exemptions (continued)

#### What is a drainage ditch?

"drainage ditch" means an artificial watercourse, added to the natural land drainage system, primarily to collect and convey water and that, for some period each year, does not contain moving water.

#### A Permit exemption applies if:

- The pesticide application is to a completely contained pond (i.e. no inflow or out flow at any time) located within the property boundaries (Ontario Regulation 63/09 Section 83(3)).
- Property owner may apply to the Director for a letter confirming exemption.
   The letter permits the property owner to purchase the pesticide
- Note: If an exterminator is hired to apply pesticides to a contained pond, a permit will be required
- In all other cases a permit will be required



# **Aquatic Pesticide Permits**

How to Apply for a Permit

A complete permit application package includes the following:

- Completed application form (signed by the exterminator)
- Proof of water lot ownership and letter of permission from water lot owner <u>or</u> proof that the water lot is Crown land
- Location map(s) showing where the site is located
- Detailed site map(s) of the application area



# Filling out the Application Form

- Provide applicant information
- Identify target pest (e.g. phragmites)
- Include the name of the pesticide, PCP number and active ingredient
- Type of application (i.e. will be ground)
- Application rate is found on the pesticide product label
- Quantity will be based on the application rate and size of treatment area (hectares)
- Previous application information (if applicable)


### **Exterminator Check List**

- Include length, width and depth of the treatment area. If there are multiple treatment areas, the dimensions can be listed on a separate page.
- Include the name of the property owner and the name of the water body (if the water body has no name give a description). Provide property address.
- Determine what activities are associated with the water body and use the check box to identify them (there may be multiple).
- Identify any objectors to the treatment. Reasonable effort must be made to determine if any adjacent water users have objections to the use of the pesticide. Objectors must be provided with information to make submissions to the Director regarding the use of the pesticide
- ✓ Exterminator/Operator information. Exterminator must sign and date the form.



# **Supplementary Information**

- Permission letter from water lot owner
- Determine if water lot is Crown land or if it is owned by another entity. The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) and/or the municipality may be able to help identify the water lot ownership. In some cases, water lots may be federal land (e.g. Trent Severn Waterway).
- Provide a letter of permission from the water lot owner indicating that pesticides may be used on the property. If the area is Crown land, then a letter from the occupier or organization responsible for management of the treatment area will be required.
- If multiple properties are included in the application, then permission from each property owner is required.





# **Supplementary Information: Maps**

Maps can be hand drawn or generated via mapping software. Electronic maps are preferred.

**Location map:** This map will show the location of the treatment sites in relation to major cities or towns

**Site maps:** Must be as detailed as possible for a thorough review. Include the following information:

- Location of the application area in relation to neighbouring properties;
- Location of public access points or public use areas in or near the application area (if applicable);
- Location of any water intakes, docks, boat slips on the treatment property and neighboring properties;
- Location of the treatment area including length, width and area measurements (metric preferred);
- Location of any identified sensitive receptors in or near the application area such as designated environmentally sensitive areas, fish sanctuaries, sensitive tree species or other vegetation.






# **How to Submit Your Permit Application**

## The Review Process

- Permit documentation is checked for completeness
- Any missing documentation or information will be requested
- Substantially incomplete or inaccurate permit applications will be returned
- Permit application form is reviewed and compared to other support documentation
- Rate and amount of pesticide confirmed
- Licence information of exterminator confirmed
- Proposed extermination compared with pesticide label requirements and provincial legislation
- Review of potential environmental impacts
- Modification to project or additional information may be requested





# When You Receive Your Permit

#### Review all information in the permit

- Application window
- Application rate
- Amount of pesticide permitted
- Number of applications permitted
- Review the permit conditions (e.g. reporting requirement)
- Conditions included in the permit are provided to reduce risk of human health and environmental impacts
- Notification requirements of pesticide use are also included in the permit conditions

# Disagreement with limitations or conditions in the permit

- Within 3 days the applicant may submit to the Director to vary or rescind a decision
- Within 15 days the applicant may request a hearing of the Ontario Land Tribunal





# Other Legislation That May Apply

### **Endangered Species Act (Ontario)**

- Species at Risk Regulations may require additional review or permits. Some exemptions apply for certain project types

# **Important Considerations**

- Phragmites control requires an integrated management approach to be successful
- Herbicides are only a part of the strategy
- Treatment of Phragmites in <u>water</u> is not subject to Ontario's Cosmetic Pesticide Ban
- Treatment of Phragmites on <u>land</u> is subject to restrictions under Ontario's Cosmetic Pesticide Ban. The natural resources exemption under Regulation 63/09 (Section 28) may apply.
- Land and water-based programs may require both a permit for the aquatic treatment and letter of opinion from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry for land and water treatments
